Rent Control Refresher AB 1482

"Just Cause Eviction"

Limits the ability to issue a Notice to Vacate

Most Abused Reasons

Owner moving into Property...Substantial Remodel!

Top 6 New California Rental Legislation Laws in 2024

SB 567 - Tightens requirements false "Owner Move-in and Substantial Remodel" and enhances penalties (3 times actual damages, civil fines, punitive damages, attorneys' fees)

AB 12 - Security deposit limited to one month's rent -Exception is Small Landlords (2 properties, 4 total units)

SB 267 - Tenant screening "Ability to Pay" rather than credit report for Sect. 8 and Govt. assist programs

AB 968 - Flipper Disclosures – Disclose all work and workers

SB 71 - Increased small claims court limit - \$10,000 to \$12,500

AB 1033 - ADU's may be sold separately as a CONDO - Lender and local agency approval



Annual Change in Median Rent


Sacramento, CA: 2019 - Present

• All Others 260,000

575,000 single family homes owned by Hedge Funds and Private Investment firms (2.3% of all 82M SFR's)

INVH Owns 85,000 of the 16M to 24M Rentals

Less than 1% of all US SFR rentals but their data is still valuable



Q3 2023 saw Invitation Homes acquire more homes than in any other quarter since it became a publicly traded company in early 2017.
